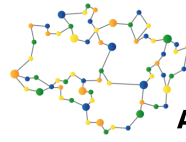

<p><b>Purpose</b></p>	<p>The Amazon Fund aims to raise grants for non-refundable investments in actions to prevent, monitor and combat deforestation, and promote the conservation and sustainable use of the Legal Amazon.</p>	<p><b>The MPTF Fund for the Amazon</b> aims to raise grants for non-refundable investments in actions to accelerate the sustainable development of the Brazilian Legal Amazon in an integrated and cooperative way.</p>
<p><b>Focus</b></p>	<p>Natural Resources</p>	<p>Generate economic alternatives and benefit the region's most vulnerable population subgroups, protecting their livelihoods and ensuring their physical, water, energy, climate, health and food security.</p>

<p><b>Scope</b></p>	<p>(in accordance with the Decree 8,773, 2016)</p> <p>I - management of public forests and protected areas;          II - environmental control, monitoring and supervision;          III - sustainable forest management;          IV - economic activities developed from the sustainable use of forests;          IV - economic activities developed from the sustainable use of vegetation; (Wording given by Decree nº 8.773, 2016)          V - Ecological and Economic Zoning, territorial planning and land regularization;          VI - conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity; and          VII - recovery of deforested areas.</p>	<p>A. Strengthening governance mechanisms to promote sustainable territorial development and the effectiveness of national laws, reducing illicit activities.</p> <p>B. Promoting sustainable and inclusive economic development in harmony with natural ecosystems, with a view to transitioning to a new regional development model.</p> <p>C. Empowering the population living in the region (forest, rural areas and urban centres), and supporting sustainable cities and human settlements.</p> <p>D. Strengthening the management of socio-environmental issues (e.g. urban solid waste, greenhouse gas emissions, release of pollutants into air, water and soil) and risk management, mitigating the causes, increasing resilience and adapting to adverse effects.</p>
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<p><b>Management and Governance</b></p>	<p>(New wording given by Decree 11.368 of 2023)</p> <p>The Fund is managed by the Brazilian Development Bank - BNDES, responsible for contracting and monitoring supported projects and publicizing activities and results.</p> <p>The governance structure has two bodies: 1) the Amazon Fund Technical Committee - CTFA, made up of six researchers appointed by the MMA whose responsibility is to certify reductions in greenhouse gas emissions from deforestation; and 2) the Amazon Fund Guidance Committee - COFA, made up of representatives from the Federal Government, state governments in the Amazon that have Programs for Prevention and Control of Deforestation and Burning - PPCDQ and civil society. Its function is to determine the guidelines and monitor the results obtained by the Fund, always in compliance with the provisions of the Action Plan for the Prevention and Control of Deforestation in the Legal Amazon - PPCDAM and ENREDD+.</p>	<p>Governance at three levels:</p> <p>1) Coordination and operation (Steering Committee, Thematic Technical Committees and Fund Secretariat); 2) Fund Administration (MPTF Office); and 3) Implementation (implementing entities).</p>
